The exhibition will be open to all members of the public during this period. Judging will take place and winners announced on Sunday **September 30<sup>th</sup> 2018**. All entrants are invited to attend on this day and winners announced at 3pm. There will be trophy prizes for winners and runners up in each category and age group. **POPPY ART COMPETITION RULES**

**(The boring, but important, bits!)**

1. The competition is open to *anyone* wishing to take part.
2. Entries are divided into three Art Medium ([Painting/Drawing/Mixed Media](#) – [Photography/Graphic Design](#) – [Sculpture/Textiles](#)), and three Age Group categories (11years and below/12-18years/Adult).
3. Any single person may enter one item, per category (e.g. a person may enter three items in total, one in each medium category).
4. All Art Work must be the original work of the entrant.
5. The competition will be judged against the simple criteria of composition / design based on the 'theme of the poppy' with a range of interpretation allowed and welcomed!
6. Entry fees will apply to each individual entry.
7. The closing date for the competition is midnight on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018**.
8. All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and appropriate fee (all proceeds are going to the Royal British Legion's 2018 Poppy Appeal).
9. Entries may be submitted by post, accompanied by a completed entry form, to the postal address contained within the entry form.
10. If you would like confirmation that your postal entry has been received please ensure you have completed contact details on the entry form (confirmation will be telephone or email only).
11. The competition will be judged by Sir Andrew Pulford (RBL Branch President), Plant Manager of Tarmac Barnstone Cement (competition sponsors), and Mrs Julie Powell (Art Competition Designer and Art Teacher). As this is a fund-raising competition, there are no eligibility restrictions on entry by any relative (or employee) of the above.
12. The Judges decisions will be final.
13. The exhibition of submissions and judging process will be held at the Granby Village Hall on **Saturday 29<sup>th</sup>** and **Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018** – and will be open to the public throughout.
14. Winners will be notified on, or after, **Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018**. Prizes will be awarded at this same time.
15. Entrants may either collect their Art Work on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> at the end of the competition (anticipated to be at 4pm) or from the Event Organisers (address is on the Entry Form) by arrangement. We regret we will be unlikely to be able to post work back to Entrants as this would detract from fund raising.
16. Copyright for each entry remains with the originator, however winners of the various categories give the organisers the right to publicise, and to display (up to an including the Remembrance Parade and Service Weekend in November 2018) their work.
