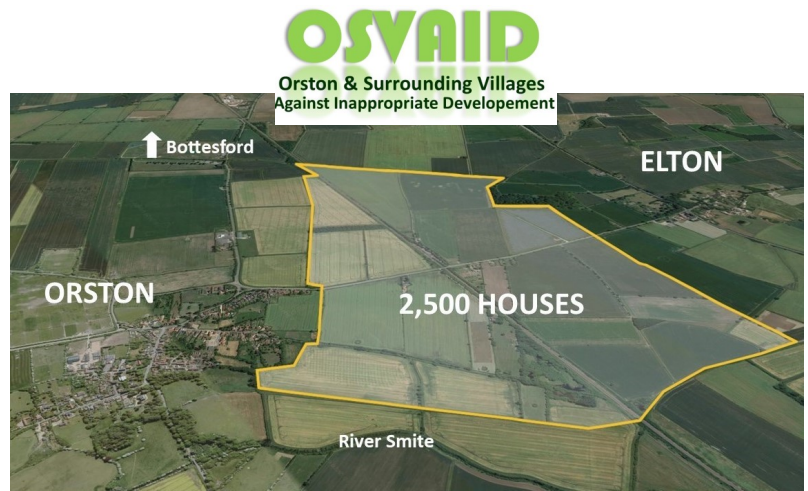

OSVAID have engaged a Planning Consultant to prepare a formal response from a planning perspective to fight the local authority's proposal of creating a new 'Garden Village' of up to 5,000 houses between the villages of Orston and Elton-on-the-Hill.

To help with these objections we need as many individuals as possible, over the age of 18, in the area to send their objections to the Greater Nottingham Strategic Plan and also to your local MP Robert Jenrick.

We will be holding two open sessions at Orston Village Hall where your questions on the new 'Garden Village' can be answered—to the best of our knowledge at this time—and there will be letters for you to sign, if you so wish, which we will be delivered by hand to Rushcliffe.

The village hall will be set up within Covid 19 restrictions. There will be a one way system and restriction of numbers within the building at any one time. So please be patient if you have to wait outside. **Please remember to bring your mask.**
